


903rd Marauders Administrative SOP #1: Code of Conduct

(Revision 11)



1 Scope

1.1 The scope of this SOP covers the proper use of the 903rd Marauders Website or any voice client provided by the 903rd Marauders and the proper ways to portray/partake in the 903rd Marauders community.

2 Purpose

2.1 This SOP shall provide clear, immutable rules that shall be followed by those participating in the 903rd Marauders, its website, its Divisions, and/or its voice client services.

3 Definitions

3.1 See “903rd Marauders Administrative SOP #4: Definitions” for definitions of underlined words, terms, and/or phrases.

4 Website Policies

4.1 The 903rd Marauders Website is a nexus of information for both the 903rd Marauders as a whole and all its Divisions. Consequentially, the following are prohibited:

4.1.1 Advertising gaming communities that are not affiliated with the 903rd Marauders.

4.1.2 Posting pictures, videos, or links to sites that feature explicit nudity.

4.1.3 Attempting to extract personal information from any member of the community.

4.1.4 Posting links to sites with malicious content or using this website in any way to affect hardware/software maliciously.

4.1.5 Using racial, provocative, or hurtful language with the intent of causing harm.

4.1.5.1 It should be noted that multiple reports of such language shall result in Regulatory Actions (even with regard to the possibility of humorous intent).

4.1.6 Sharing the personal information of others.

4.1.7 Providing false personal information, posing as another member of the community, or posing as or stealing the personae of others.

4.2 Any voluntary posting of one's own personal information or pictures/videos

depends on one's own discretion.

4.2.1 It should be noted that the 903rd Marauders shall not be held accountable for any negative effects which arise from posting the aforementioned.

4.3 Repetitive, wanton, and/or overly excessive posting.

5 Voice Client Policies

5.1 Any voice client provided by the 903rd Marauders is provided in order to make one's gaming experience with the 903rd Marauders a pleasant one. Consequentially, the following are prohibited:

5.1.1 Performing any prohibited action listed above in section 4.1 (including its subsections) of this SOP.

5.1.2 Playing music outside an area specifically created (and clearly marked) for the purpose of sharing music without the permission of a Master or Director.

5.1.3 Making repetitive, wanton, and/or overly excessive noise with the intent to annoy or hurt other patrons of the voice client.

5.1.4 Masters and Directors may temporarily suspend any patron of any voice client provided by the 903rd Marauders for violating any of the rules listed above.

5.1.4.1 All suspensions will result in a request for a Regulatory Action.

5.2 Any voluntary sharing of one's own personal information or pictures/videos depends on one's own discretion.

5.2.1 It should be noted that the 903rd Marauders shall not be held accountable for any negative effects which arise from posting the aforementioned.

6 Representing the Community

6.1 All members of the 903rd Marauders represent the community as a whole. Consequentially, the following are prohibited (when any affiliation or connection to the 903rd Marauders under any medium is evident or traceable):

6.1.1 Performing any prohibited action listed above in sections 4.1 or 5.1 (including their subsections) of this SOP. While streaming games featuring nudity, pornography, sex, sexual violence, and game play modified to feature these elements are prohibited, occurrences of in-game nudity are permitted (so long as it is not a primary focus of the content).

6.1.2 Making repetitive, wanton, and/or overly excessive noise with the intent to

annoy or hurt others.

6.1.3 Hacking, stealing, or pirating any software/hardware, especially those provided by the 903rd Marauders.

6.1.3.1 Any form of using third party programs or hacking to enhance one's abilities in any game is also prohibited and, in most cases, will result in a permanent ban from the community.

6.1.4 Bullying, insulting, subordinating, or patronizing others.

6.1.5 Any theft of in-game content from any of the Divisions or their holdings.

6.2 Masters, Directors, and Officers are especially expected to represent the community in a sophisticated and professional manner at all times.

7 Requisitions For Regulatory Actions

7.1 The following must be provided/met in order to request a Regulatory Action:

7.1.1 The date/time of the violation, the medium in which it occurred, and the community rank/identifying factors of the accused.

7.1.2 Any request shall be posed to the Master Arbiter via private message on any platform administered by the 903rd Marauders community.

7.1.3 Requests made by those with the rank of Marauder must provide two witnesses.

7.1.4 Requests made by those with the rank of Officer must provide one witness.

7.2 If the previous stipulations are satisfied, the Master Arbiter shall bring the violation to discussion during the closed portion of the next scheduled Community Meeting and moderate the voting process for any Regulatory Actions that may be proposed.

7.2.1 Any Masters, Directors, and/or Officers who are not present or are unresponsive when the request is brought to discussion shall have their votes considered to be forfeit.

7.2.2 For community emergencies, any two Masters or one Master and two Directors may make a Regulatory Action at the time of the emergency or directly following it (and report the results to the Master Arbiter afterward).

7.2.2.1 Community emergencies include: situations which cause or may

cause direct danger to the community's structure, any attempt at corrupting the integrity of the 903rd Marauders Website or voice client services provided by the 903rd Marauders, or any unofficial recruitment of new Marauders.

8 Final Statement and Authorization

8.1 I, Ecaobia, Master Arbiter of the 903rd Marauders, hereby authorize and initialize this document and its contents on this seventeenth day of November, two thousand and thirteen. May glory be given to the 903rd Marauders, may we strive forward, under the ideals of its community, and may we never forget the victories which have, and surely will, follow in its wake.

9 Document History

9.3.1 Enabled Masters and Directors to initiate thirty minute bans on patrons of any voice clients provided by the community. This new ability was included in section 5.

9.4 Tuesday, January 27, 2015:

9.4.1 Added a statement in section 6 that prohibits the stealing of in-game content.

9.4.2 Revision number set to three.

9.5 Sunday, January 7, 2018:

9.5.1 Added a statement in section 5 that prohibits the use of software or hardware to modify one's voice.

9.5.2 Revision number set to four.

9.6 Sunday, January 21, 2018:

9.6.1 Removed the statement in section 5 which prohibited the use of software or hardware to modify one's voice. The motion which put it in place was passed in error since only a simple majority was in favor of its passing.

9.6.2 Revision number set to five.

9.7 Sunday, September 23, 2018:

9.7.1 Changed the text in 5.1.4 and its subsection to allow for temporary bans from voice clients instead of thirty minute bans.

9.7.2 Revision number set to six.

9.8 Sunday, February 10, 2019:

9.8.1 Changed the text in 6.1.1 to add an exception to 4.1.2 for streaming games with mature content.

9.8.2 Revision number changed to seven.

9.9 Sunday, July 7, 2019:

9.9.1 Changed the text in 7.1.2 such that patrons may request Regulatory Actions on any platform administered by the community.

9.9.2 Revision number changed to eight.

9.10 Tuesday, February 4, 2020:

9.10.1 Changed all mentions of the 903rd Marauders Forum to the 903rd Marauders Website.

9.10.2 Removed a subsection in section 4 that concerned forum posts.

9.10.3 Changed section 7 such that requests for Regulatory Actions may be posed to the Master Arbiter on any platform administered by the 903rd Marauders community.

9.10.4 Revision number set to nine.

9.11 Sunday, August 23, 2020

9.11.1 Removed all mentions of Directors and Divisions and changed wording accordingly.

9.11.2 Revision number set to ten.
